## THE 2018 VINTAGE

2018 in its entirety gave way to one of the Sonoma Coast's most elegant growing seasons in recent memory. A near-perfect vintage started with above-average rains for the second year in a row. These rains continued to breathe life into the soils, streams, rivers, and lakes of California. In the spring, flowering occurred under warmer and more forgiving times, allowing for full and healthy clusters across all of our vineyards.

As the season progressed, temperatures stayed cool and continued to be cool up until harvest. This long, cool ripening period led to incredible phenological and flavor development, all while retaining the acidity and holding back the sugar development. Yields for RAEN were on the modest side, producing wines of depth, elegance, and vibrancy. All in all, 2018 marks a truly classic, elegant, and near-perfect vintage for RAEN.
